### GENERAL INFORMATION

Choice Weather Master® is a water conditioner.

**SUGGESTED USE RATE: Add Choice Weather Master to the water in the tank before any other pesticides or adjuvants.**

250-750mL or 0.25-0.75% V/V of Choice Weather Master per 100 litres of water.

**Per hectare:** A dose of 600mL of Choice Weather Master per hectare has demonstrated performance equal to 2.25kg of Ammonium Sulfate.

**Note:** This product has demonstrated excellent plant safety; however, not all species of ornamentals have been tested. Before treating a large area, test on a small area and observe prior to full-scale application. Higher mineral content in water will require the higher rates of Choice Weather Master. This product does not replace requirement of adding surfactant.

### ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

DO NOT apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. DO NOT contaminate water when cleaning equipment or disposing of equipment wash-waters.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in the closed, original container in a dry, cool, well-ventilated area out of direct sunlight. Store in a locked room or place away from children, animals, food, feedstuffs, seed and fertilisers. Avoid preparation of excess spray, but if necessary, spray out excess mixed sprays or dispose of in a soil pit which does not drain into waters or ponds. Degradation of excess material may be hastened by making solutions alkaline with lime or washing soda. Triple rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. DO NOT dispose of undiluted chemical on-site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If not recycling, break, crush or puncture and deliver empty packaging for appropriate disposal to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available, bury the empty packaging 500mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulations. DO NOT burn empty containers or product.
